

My teenager has completed the Permit Class at Wise Driving School. What do I have to do now?

1st You will need to visit any DPS Office to get your kiddos Learner's License. Most are taking walk-ins. It is recommended that you show up about 7:00am and stand in line and if your fortunate enough you might get a walk-in ticket. Those that would rather not wait in line *can make an appointment by visiting <https://public.txdpsscheduler.com>* Where you will select "Apply For First Time Texas DL" If you are willing to drive several hours then you might be able to get an appointment sooner rather than later.

2nd - After your son or daughter has their Permit, you must apply with Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation as your student's Instructor or you may designate someone that is at least 25 years old and has held a license for at least 7 years. You can find this link at wisedriving-school.net after you select "**Parent-Taught Curb Buster #104**". You will click on **Apply with TDLR** and then you will click on **Parent-Taught Driver Education Instructor Designation Services Request** where you be asked to pay TDLR a \$20 fee.

3rd – You must provide Wise Driving School with your **TDLR Parent Taught Driver Education Program Guide Receipt Page**. Once you bring the Receipt Page you will be given the Parent-Taught Curb Buster #104 Program.

4th - After your child completes the remaining Curb Buster Parent Taught Classroom Lessons 4-16 then you will bring their Classroom Log to our office. We will then transfer your student's classroom logs to Curb Buster and they will issue your child a Final Driver Ed Certificate (DE-964) which we will keep in your student's file here in our office.

5th -Your child is at least 16 and has held a driver's permit for a minimum of six months and has completed his/her 14 hour In-Car driving Log & the 30-hour driving log then you may schedule your child's driving test at **Wise Driving School** or any DPS office.

Required documents for Driver's License Road Test

- 1) For Driver's License Only DE-964 Certificate
- 2) 30-hour Behind the Wheel Driving Log
- 3) 14-hour Parent Taught Driving log
- 4) IMPACT Video ITTD Certificate ****Must not be expired****

6th -Once your child passes his/her driving test at Wise Driving School we will insert all required documents into a sealed envelope.

Finally, you will then take this sealed envelope to any DPS office. Your child will then be required to "Smile Big" for their Driver's License photo!!!
